

ALL SAINTS CHAPEL



110 S. EAST STREET
RALEIGH, NC 27601

Built in 1874 as the Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd with plans by the Reverend Johannes Adam Simon Oertel

Declared a Cathedral from 1893 until 1914 when the new Good Shepherd sanctuary opened

Designated a Raleigh Historic Property in 1979



Great location just blocks from an urban green park, Moore Square, which is flanked by arts and cultural entertainment venues and restaurants

- Built in a gothic cross configuration, highlighted by five clerestory windows on either side of the five-bay nave
- Architectural details include vertical tongue-and-groove wainscot, exposed timbers, corbelled arch wall posts and molded cornices
- Stained glass windows purchased with money raised by 19th century Sunday school children
- Perfect for church or venue for weddings and other special functions
